Motuihe Island, a jewel in the Hauraki Gulf with its close proximity to Auckland City, is now a wonderful tourist and educational attraction. The vision of the Trust is for Motuihe Island to provide a natural environment of indigenous flora and fauna together with identified significant historic sites, offering a quality recreational, environmental and educational experience to visitors. Visitors to the island are able to watch native birds in their native habitat, close to the beautiful white sandy beaches. Visitors are actively encouraged to walk around the island and learn about conservation of the Hauraki Gulf. Department of Conservation representatives are extremely positive and supportive of this project.

We are anticipating another great year with native planting continuing by people from all areas of the school, business and private community. Over 430,000 plants propagated in the island's nursery have been planted by volunteers, and still counting.

Visitors and volunteers have been thrilled to sight translocated Kakariki, Saddleback, Bellbirds, Whiteheads, Little Spotted Kiwi, Tuatara, a variety of skinks and geckos. By engaging with Motuihe volunteers, visitors to the island have learnt about the fascinating translocation and restoration process.
